Guidelines for poster presentations

**Formatting: The poster presentation sessions will be conducted as e-posters only.
Therefore, printing is not required.**

E poster Presentations should be in JPEG (image)

- Use the provided template for e-posters
- Font – Arial or Calibri (minimum font size is 20)
- The poster should be easily readable at a distance. Use upper and lower case for general content, as all-capital text is difficult to read. Maintain consistency in Font choice and size.
- Background color – Suitable light colour
- File format - Microsoft PowerPoint (.ppt or .pptx)
- Final version to be saved as jpeg.
- Margins – Half an inch on all sides
- Layout - Landscape orientation (figure 1)
- The poster should be displayed on **ONE single slide ONLY**
- The poster should contain the title of the paper, author(s), and affiliation(s), background, objectives, method, results, conclusion (acknowledgment if applicable).
- As a poster is a visual tool it needs to maintain a logical structure in order that a viewer can easily follow and understand your argument from start to finish. Consider in including an introduction, methodology, results and discussion, conclusion, and most important references (Figure 1).
- Please prepare Four Color, **36”×48” (3’×4’)** size slide for the presentations in **JPEG (image)**.

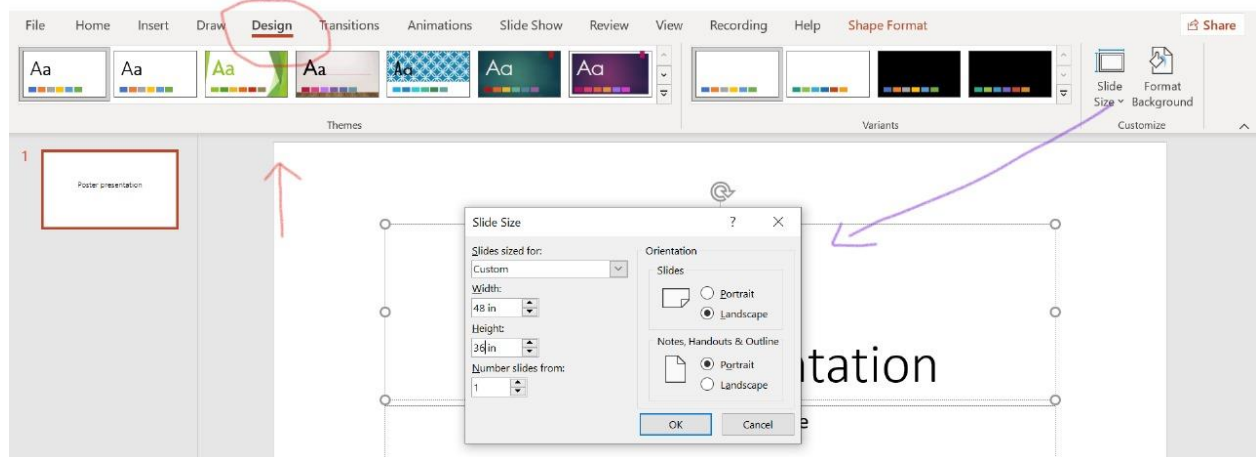
