Rules and Regulations

1. General Rules

Eligibility

> The quiz is open to BAMS undergraduates of all the Professional Stages at the Faculty of Indigenous Medicine, University of Colombo.

Registration

- > Registration is required to participate in the competition.
- > Contestants should be registered as a group of three contestants with the composition of,
 - One Contestant from First Professional Stage
 - One Contestant from Second Professional Stage
 - One Contestant from Third Professional Stage
- All groups must register before the deadline (30.09.2024) via filling and submitting the provided Application form in the link below.

- ➤ Duly filled application should be submitted to the Department of Basic Principles, Ayurveda Anatomy and Physiology or to the Email Address <u>duliniamarasiri@fim.cmb.ac.lk</u> on or before 30th September 2024 with Passport size photographs (Soft copies) of all the three contestants of the group.

Participation

- All the contestants must be present at the venue at least 30 minutes before the quiz starts.
- Latecomers may be disqualified or not allowed to participate in the quiz.

Identification

> Contestants are required to show identification or proof of registration upon request.

2. Quiz Format

Rounds

- > The quiz will consist of multiple rounds.
- > The exact format and number of rounds will be announced at the start of the quiz.

Time Limit

- Each round will have a specific time limit. Contestants must answer within this time frame.
- > Late answers will not be accepted.

Scoring

- > Points will be awarded for correct answers. Incorrect answers may result in no points or deduction based on the quiz format.
- > The group of contestants with the highest score at the end of all rounds will be declared the winner.

Tie breaker

➤ In case of a tie, a tiebreaker question or additional rounds may be used to determine the winner.

3. Conduct and behavior

Fair Play

- > Groups must answer questions independently. Assistance from others is not permitted.
- > Cheating or dishonesty will result in immediate disqualification.

Respect and Decorum

- > Contestants must show respect to other contestants, the judge panel, and the organizers.
- Disruptive behavior or disrespect will not be tolerated and may result in disqualification.

Electronic Devices

- The use of electronic devices (e.g., smartphones, tablets) during the quiz is prohibited.
- > Devices must be kept silent and stored away during the competition.

4. Certificates and Awards

Certificates

Certificates will be awarded to all the contestants (Winners, First Runners Up, Second Runners Up, Certificate of Participation).

Awards and Award Distribution

- Winners will be announced at the end of the competition.
- Awards will be distributed during the occasion of the World Ayurveda Day Commemoration on 01st November 2024.

- ➤ The organizers reserve the right to make changes to the rules, quiz format, or schedule if necessary.
- ➤ Contestants will be informed of any changes in advance.
