The overall aim of this Postgraduate Diploma is to ensure that the trainee gains adequate knowledge, clinical acumen, procedural skills, communicative skills and attitudes which will enable him to; manage maternal and child nutritional states and disease conditions related to childhood. The trainee should also acquire the professional skills to establish and enhance comprehensive, community-based, nutrition-oriented and culturally competent coordinated care by increasing the availability of Ayurveda medical practitioners trained in child nutrition that can meet the needs of the target population.

Who is eligible to apply for the course?

- A Bachelor of Ayurveda Medicine and Surgery (BAMS) degree from a recognized institution or equivalent qualification; Diploma in Ayurveda Medicine and Surgery (DAMS) and Diploma in Siddha Ayurveda Medicine and Surgery (DSAMS)
- Those who are undergoing an internship period
- Completion of one-year internship and registration under the Ayurveda Medical Council
- Satisfactory completion of one year of work experience acceptable to the FIM
