- Can include the text relevant to the theme.

• Competitors should design the poster within the assigned time on an allocated date at the faculty premises.

Ethics and Conduct:

The criterion for judging:

- **Relevance** [content of the poster should be relevant to the competition theme] 20%
- Visual Appeal [use of colors, fonts, images and overall design should be pleasing] 20%
- Uniqueness and creativity [Design should be unique and creative] 20%
- **Organization** [Information should be logically arranged] 10%
- Adherence to guidelines [Following specific rules and guideline] 10%
- **Impact** [Ability of the poster to effectively influence in audience 10%
- **Readability** [Text should be easy to read from a distance appropriate font size and style] -10%
