- Participants are required to submit a 3-5 minute video presenting role of Ayurveda in promoting health, wellness, and sustainability, aligned with the theme of World Ayurveda Day 2024
- Participants should be undergraduates of the Faculty of Indigenous Medicine.

2. Video Format (Technical Specifications)

- Duration: 3-5 minutes
- Video Resolution: 1080p
- Frame rate: 25 fps
- Language: English or Sinhala
- Submissions can include animations, interviews, creative storytelling, demonstrations, or a combination of these elements
- Videos must be submitted in MP4 format with a minimum resolution of 720p
- o Bit Rate: 8 Mbps
- Video codec: H.264
- Audio: 48000 Hz (192 kbps)

- o File Format: MP4

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4. Evaluation Criteria

- **Content** (40%): Relevance to the theme, accuracy of information, adherence to Ayurvedic principles
- Creativity (30%): Originality, uniqueness, and innovative presentation methods
- Visual Quality (20%): Clarity, technical quality, and overall production value
- o Impact (10%): Audience engagement, message clarity, and overall effectiveness
